

How to fill out TR-128 — Lienholder's Consent to Transfer Vehicle Ownership

Kansas · written against TR-128 (07/24), issued under K.S.A. 8-135(c)(1)

The narrowest form in the Kansas set, and the one whose limits matter more than its blanks. Kansas law forbids issuing a title with an unreleased lien unless the transfer has been consented to in writing by the lienholder, and this is that consent - but the sheet's own NOTE confines it to one family of transfers: adding an immediate family member, spouse, father, mother, son or daughter, removing a name, or a name change from marriage or court order, on a Kansas electronic or paperless title, with at least one previous owner remaining. Any other assignment, the form says in capitals, must be obtained on a Kansas paper title.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank TR-128 from the Kansas Department of Revenue, Division of Vehicles at <https://www.ksrevenue.gov/pdf/tr128.pdf?f=ks-tr128.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	YOU	Check the NOTE before anything	The paragraph in the middle of the sheet that says who this form is for: adding a spouse, father, mother, son or daughter, removing a name, or a marriage or court-order name change, on an electronic title, with an original owner remaining. Watch out: If your transfer is not on that list, stop here - the capitals say any other assignment must be obtained on a Kansas paper title, and that means a lien release first.
2	YOU	Vehicle and current owner	ID number, year, make, model, and the owner names exactly as the Kansas certificate of title carries them. Watch out: No corrections, ever - the header voids the form on any alteration or erasure, so a slip means printing a fresh sheet, not reaching for correction fluid.
3	LENDER	The lender's sworn consent	Their name and address, the authorized signature and date, and the notary block - subscribed and sworn, commission expiry, seal. Watch out: Book this signature first; it is the slow one. The credit union's officer, their notary and their diary set this form's timeline, not yours.
4	YOU	The new owner	Relationship, name(s), address, and the date the assignment was filled out. Watch out: The relationship word is checked against the NOTE's list, not the tax list - spouse, father, mother, son, daughter. Write the one that is true and on the list, or this is the wrong form.
5	YOU	Three signatures, then the county	Your signature and hand printed name, the new owner's signature under the awareness sentence, and the trip to the treasurer. Watch out: The closing paragraph gives Kansas residents 30 days from the assignment to apply at the county where the vehicle is garaged - and the departing name should reread the warning that leaving the title may not mean leaving the loan.

What gets this one rejected

- Using it to sell to a stranger. The NOTE's capitals settle it - any other type of assignment must be obtained on a Kansas paper title - and a paper title for a lien vehicle only exists after a release. A financed sale to a non-relative runs on the TR-39a and a payoff, not on this sheet.
- Using it when Kansas has issued a paper title. The form's own sentence: if Kansas has issued a paper title, this assignment cannot be used.
- Removing every original owner. The transfer works with at least one of the previous owners remaining as an owner on the new Kansas title - a complete change of hands is exactly what this form refuses to carry.
- An unsworn consent. The lienholder's signature block is built around the notary - subscribed and sworn, commission expiry, seal - because a Kansas lienholder's consent is one of the documents the Division's notary rule actually covers.
- Any correction on the face. The header's warning is absolute: any alterations or erasures will void this form.
