

# How to fill out MV11AB — Statement of Correction

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Montana · written against MV11AB (8/26), issued under MCA 61-3-202(3), cancellation or correction of a certificate of title containing an error

For when the title itself is wrong about the car - a body style recorded as a wagon on a vehicle that is a sport utility, a colour that was never right, a model that lost a trim designation somewhere in the record, a VIN that does not match the plate on the dash. The division's title page puts it simply: do you see an error on your title? Complete a Statement of Correction and send it to the Vehicle Services Bureau with any documents that support the request. A corrected title costs \$10.30, the same as a replacement, and the reason a seller should care is that a buyer's county treasurer compares the certificate against the vehicle in the car park.

| 1 | YOU | <b>Section 1: the vehicle as the title has it</b> | Year, make, model, colour, body style and VIN, copied from the certificate exactly - errors included. <b>Watch out:</b> Transcribe it, do not tidy it. The bureau is comparing this against its own record, and a corrected transcription hides the very thing you are reporting.                   |
| 2 | YOU | <b>Section 2: where the new title goes</b>        | Name, address, email and phone for the corrected certificate. <b>Watch out:</b> Titles are not mailed to in-state third parties as a matter of course. If it needs to go somewhere other than the owner's own address, expect to explain why.                                                       |
| 3 | YOU | <b>Section 3: the vehicle as it actually is</b>   | The same six fields, correct, under the form's statement that a physical check discloses them to be correct. <b>Watch out:</b> Change only what is wrong. A section 3 that differs from section 1 in five places when one is at issue invites the bureau to ask which of the two describes the car. |
| 4 | YOU | <b>Describe the change, and attach the proof</b>  | A plain description of what is wrong and what it should be, with supporting documentation as needed. <b>Watch out:</b> A photograph of the federal certification label in the driver's door frame settles most body-style and model disputes in one page.                                           |
| 5 | YOU | <b>Section 4: the registered owner signs</b>      | Signature, identification number, date, and a printed business name where a company owns the vehicle. <b>Watch out:</b> The registered owner signs - not a buyer who has agreed to take the car once it is corrected. Until the title changes hands the record is still yours to fix.               |

### What gets this one rejected

- The same information in sections 1 and 3. The form is a before and an after; identical rows tell the bureau nothing needs correcting.
- A correction asserted with nothing behind it. The form asks for supporting documentation as needed, and a VIN or body-style change is exactly the case where the bureau wants a photograph of the door label or an inspection.
- An owner's signature missing its identification number. The field sits beside the signature and is how the bureau matches the request to the record.
- Using it to change ownership. It corrects a description; it does not move an interest, and the assignment on the title is untouched by it.
- Using it to fix a mistake somebody made in ink on the certificate. That is an MV100 explanation at best, and a voided title needing an MV7 at worst - this form is about what the department printed, not about what was written on it afterwards.
