

How to fill out MV90A — Odometer Disclosure Statement

Montana · written against MV90A (4/26), issued under MCA 61-3-206 and the federal Truth in Mileage Act; sworn under MCA 45-7-203

The separate mileage sheet, for when the title itself has nowhere to record it. Montana has issued conforming titles - ones with the certification printed in the assignment - since August 1989, so most sales never need this. It comes out when the document in your hand is older or foreign and has no odometer space, when a break/bond or salvage application needs a conforming statement attached, and whenever the buyer's application and the certificate disagree about where the reading lives. Its first line is also the clearest statement of Montana's odometer rule anywhere in the division's library, and it contradicts the division's own 2026 seller leaflet.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank MV90A from the Montana Department of Justice, Motor Vehicle Division, Vehicle Services Bureau at <https://mvdmt.gov/wp-content/uploads/2026/04/MV90A-Odometer-Disclosure-Statement-04.26F.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	YOU	Section 1: the vehicle	Year, make, model, style and VIN, matching the title exactly. Watch out: A conforming statement has to identify the vehicle by make, model, year, body type and VIN. A row with the style left blank is a statement the county can refuse as non-conforming.
2	YOU	The reading, in whole miles	Tick five or six digits, write the number with no tenths, and date the day you read it. Watch out: Read it on the day you hand the car over, not the day you agreed the sale. The date the odometer was read is its own field precisely because the two can differ.
3	YOU	The two exception boxes	Exceeds mechanical limits for a cluster that has rolled over; not actual mileage where the reading is known to be wrong. Watch out: The form's own instruction is do not check unless applicable. Either tick brands the title, and the brand follows the car out of state.
4	YOU	Section 3: you, the transferor	Name and full current address. Watch out: Transferor is wider than seller here - a gift, an inheritance distribution or any transfer other than creating a security interest puts you in this box.
5	BUYER	Section 4: the buyer, the transferee	Name and full current address, on the same sheet. Watch out: A conforming statement needs both addresses. A buyer who has not moved in yet should give the address they will actually be registering the car from.
6	YOU	Section 5: both signatures, both dates	You certify the reading; the buyer signs acknowledging it. Watch out: Do not post this for the buyer to sign later. An unacknowledged disclosure is incomplete under MCA 61-3-206(2), and a mistake on it cannot be corrected - it needs a fresh form.

What gets this one rejected

- A reading written to the tenth of a mile. The form says no tenths and the manual repeats it - an odometer reading that specifies no tenths is part of what makes a statement conforming.
- The word unknown. The manual is explicit that a statement that the odometer reading is UNKNOWN may not be used and is in violation of the Truth in Mileage Act; a missing or unreadable odometer is disclosed by ticking not actual mileage and noting why.
- Only one signature. The transferee must sign to acknowledge the reading - MCA 61-3-206(2) makes the purchaser's acknowledgement part of the disclosure, not an optional courtesy.
- A correction. The manual bars statements of fact from fixing errors on odometer statements and VIN inspections: if an error is made on one of these forms, a new form must be submitted.
- This form where a secure power of attorney is needed. Its own header says so - where an attorney in fact is signing off for the registered owner, MV90A cannot be used.

This form must be completed in its entirety. Required and applies to vehicles 20 years old and newer. Model years before 2011 are exempt. A vehicle having a gross weight rating of more than 16,000 pounds is exempt. A secure Power of Attorney form must be used to acknowledge the odometer reading when the power of attorney is signing off for the registered owner (i.e. seller) as form MV90A cannot be used in this situation.
