

How to fill out RV-707 — Application for Certificate of Title

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Nebraska · written against RV-707 (Rev 7/2018), issued under Neb. Rev. Stat. s. 60-144, application to a county treasurer on the form prescribed by the department /forms/nebraska/rv-707-application-for-certificate-of-title/

The buyer's form, shown here so a Nebraska seller knows exactly what happens to the certificate they signed. One page: five brand boxes across the top - Salvage, Previously Salvaged, Flood, Non-Transferable, Manufacturer Buyback - a vehicle description down to GVWR, capacity/propulsion and a taxi-use question, room for three owners with a survivorship election, Transfer On Death beneficiaries, and a lien section that decides whether the new title exists on paper at all. The fee is printed on its face: \$10.00, plus \$7.00 if a lien is noted. Nothing on it is yours to sign, and one question on it - the OR-versus-AND election - will govern how this car is sold the next time.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank RV-707 from the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles, Driver and Vehicle Records Division at <https://dmv.nebraska.gov/sites/dmv.nebraska.gov/files/doc/dvr/forms/titleapp.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	BUYER	The brand boxes stay empty on a clean car	Salvage, Previously Salvaged, Flood, Non-Transferable and Manufacturer Buyback are ticked only when the surrendered title already carries the brand. Watch out: A brand cannot be shed by leaving the box blank - the county reads the surrendered certificate - and ticking one that does not apply invents a brand the record will then carry.
2	BUYER	Vehicle description, from the old title	VIN, year, make, model, body style, color, GVWR and capacity/propulsion, copied from the certificate rather than the windshield. Watch out: The taxi-use question is not filler - Nebraska tracks taxi service on the record, and Yes here follows the vehicle.
3	BUYER	The survivorship election	For two or more owners: No joins the names with And and sends the car through probate at a death; Yes joins them with Or and passes it to the survivor on a death certificate. Watch out: The form explains the stakes in its own parentheses, which almost nobody reads at the counter. Read them - this tick is the difference between a death certificate and a court file.
4	BUYER	Owner information, every owner	Name as it should print, Nebraska driver's license number or SSN or EIN, and date of birth, for up to three owners. Watch out: The name field is 35 characters and the county enters it surname first - a suffix like JR belongs after the given names, never in the last-name field.
5	BUYER	Transfer On Death, if wanted	One or two beneficiaries who take the vehicle at the last owner's death, printed on the title with the TOD tag. Watch out: A TOD beneficiary has no interest while the owners live and the designation can be changed at any time without their consent - it is revocable ink, not a gift.
6	BUYER	Residential address, street only	The residential line fixes situs - which county taxes and registers the car - and must be a street address; the mailing line may differ. Watch out: Situs is where the vehicle is housed the majority of the time, not where its owner would prefer to pay taxes. Counties compare notes.
7	BUYER	The lien section, and what it does to the paper	Yes requires the lienholder's name, PLID and address, a copy of the lien instrument, and \$7.00. The title then exists electronically at the DMV until the loan clears. Watch out: A buyer financing the purchase should expect no paper title in the mail - that is the design, not a lost document, and the seller-side page on lien releases explains how it comes back.
8	BUYER	Sign, under the sworn statement	Every owner going on the title signs and one dates it, beneath the warning about false or fictitious names and concealed material facts. Watch out: The exceptions are the form's own: one spouse may sign for the other, and a parent, legal guardian, foster parent or agent signs for an owner who is handicapped, disabled or too young.

What gets this one rejected

- A seller's signature anywhere on it. All owners listed above shall sign, the form says, and the owners are the buyers - the seller's signatures live on the certificate being surrendered, nowhere here.
- An application unsigned by a co-owner. Every listed owner signs, with the form's own exceptions: spouses may sign for each other, a parent or guardian signs for an owner too young or unable, and one owner suffices when an out-of-state title transfers with no ownership change.
- A survivorship election left blank when two names go on. The And-or-Or choice is not clerical - the No box means probate will be required, in the form's own words, and the county cannot guess which future the buyers wanted.
- A post office box on the residential line. The address on a Nebraska certificate must be a street address to establish situs; the county manual allows a P.O. Box only for leasing companies and Address Confidentiality Act participants.
- A lien ticked Yes with no lien instrument attached. The form requires a copy of the security agreement or equivalent with the application, and the county cannot note - or charge \$7.00 for - a lien it has not seen.
