

How to fill out TDMV 105 — Affidavit of Ownership for Antique Vehicles

New Hampshire · written against TDMV 105 (Rev 03/23), issued under RSA 261:4-a

The route to a New Hampshire title for a vehicle that never had one and cannot get one the ordinary way, because the owner holds no prior title and no prior registration. It is the only form in a seller's group that is sworn in front of a Notary Public or a Justice of the Peace, and the reason is what it certifies: that there is no paperwork behind the claim of ownership at all.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank TDMV 105 from the New Hampshire Division of Motor Vehicles at <https://www.dmv.nh.gov/sites/g/files/ehbemt416/files/inline-documents/tdmv105.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	YOU	Date and your name and address	The head of the affidavit, and the first full line. Watch out: Use the address the Division has for you. If it is out of date, the record change request is the form that fixes that, and it is worth doing first.
2	YOU	The vehicle line	Model year, make, model, colour and body style. Watch out: Model year, not the year you think of it as. On a vehicle this old the two can differ and the Bureau records the model year.
3	YOU	The identification number	The comb below the vehicle line, a character to a cell. Watch out: Pre-1981 vehicles carry a shorter number than the seventeen cells allow for. Write it in from the left and leave the spare cells empty rather than padding it out.
4	YOU	Where it came from	The date of purchase, and the name and address of the person you bought it from. Watch out: If the vehicle was inherited or given, say so on the line rather than inventing a purchase. This is a sworn document.
5	YOU	The certification	That you are not in possession of a prior title or prior registration. Watch out: If you find an old registration certificate in a drawer afterwards, that changes which form you should have used - RSA 261:2-a will accept a current or expired registration as proof of the identification number.
6	YOU	Sign in front of the official	Not before. The acknowledgement says the above named personally appeared and made oath that the declaration is true. Watch out: Take photo identification. A Justice of the Peace is as good as a Notary Public in New Hampshire and is often easier to find.
7	OTHER	The acknowledgement block	State, county, date, the name of the person who appeared, the official's signature, the commission expiration and the seal. Watch out: Check the commission expiration before you leave. An expired commission makes the whole affidavit worthless and you will not find out for weeks.

What gets this one rejected

- An unsworn affidavit. The acknowledgement block is on the form and the document does not work without it.
- An affidavit from somebody who does hold a prior title or registration - the sworn statement is that they do not, and if a registration certificate exists, this is the wrong form.
- A blank seller block. The form asks who the vehicle was purchased from and when, because that is the chain of ownership being asserted.
