

How to fill out MVD-10011 — Certificate of Transfer Without Probate

New Mexico · written against MVD-10011 (Rev 12/19), issued under Vehicle Procedures Manual, Chapter 8 Section G (Transfer Without Probate)

The second door through an unprobated estate, cut for the spouse or legal heir. Where the claiming-successor affidavit turns on the estate's size, this certificate turns on who you are: the signer certifies as heir or spouse that the vehicle was not devised by will to anyone else, that no personal-representative appointment is pending or granted anywhere, that thirty days have passed since the death, and that they are entitled to the vehicle by operation of law. Same one-page shape, same notarization, same four-box odometer disclosure - different oath.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank MVD-10011 from the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department, Motor Vehicle Division at <https://realfile.tax.newmexico.gov/mvd10011.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	OTHER	Claimant and decedent	Your name as heir or spouse, and the registered owner's as the title prints it. Watch out: If several heirs exist, sort out among yourselves who takes the vehicle before anyone swears - the certificate carries one applicant.
2	OTHER	The vehicle or vessel	Year, make, model, the VIN or hull number, and the plate or vessel number. Watch out: Copy from the certificate if it survives; from the registration if it does not, and plan on the duplicate-title step.
3	OTHER	The odometer block	Whole miles and one of the four boxes - this revision prints EX, so older vehicles are handled without contortion. Watch out: As transferor by operation of law you may certify actual mileage to the best of your knowledge; if the truck's history genuinely defeats you, NM is the honest code and nobody is punished for honesty.
4	OTHER	The four conditions	Read each numbered line - they are what your signature certifies, jointly and severally. Watch out: The 'not devised by will to anyone else' condition means you need to actually know whether a will exists and what it says. Unsure is not a box on this form.
5	OTHER	Notarize, then to the counter	Sign before the notary, then bring the certificate, the death certificate original or certified copy, and any lien release to the field office. Watch out: The division's clerk must view the death certificate and affirm they did on the retained copy - post nothing you only have one of.

What gets this one rejected

- A claimant who is neither spouse nor legal heir. This certificate's entitlement is by operation of law - a friend, a caretaker or a creditor uses the claiming-successor route or a court order, not this page.
- A will that gives the vehicle to someone else. The first sworn condition excludes exactly that case; a devised vehicle follows the will through the personal representative.
- An out-of-state version of the same idea. The manual is firm that a transfer without probate from out of state cannot be accepted - the process runs only in the jurisdiction where the vehicle was titled.
- No death certificate presented. The original or certified copy - or the military DD-1300 casualty report - must be shown, and the clerk affirms on the retained copy that they saw it.
- Sworn before the thirty days have run. The waiting period is a condition of the certificate, not a formality around it.
- A lien ignored because the borrower died. The release requirement survives the owner; the lender releases, or the lien rides onto the next title.
