

How to fill out SFN 60806 — Odometer Correction

North Dakota · written against SFN 60806 (4-2026), issued under North Dakota Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division; the odometer disclosure the Registration Manual applies under NDCC 39-05-05(1)(g)

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The heavier of North Dakota's two mileage corrections, and the one that applies once the mistake has already been printed. Where a certificate of title was issued carrying the wrong reading, this form starts the process of getting it right - and the department states the stakes in its own line halfway down: the inability to provide the below documentation may result in the title being marked WARNING NOT ACTUAL MILEAGE. It is signed by the individual who originally made the error or alteration, notarised, and sent with four other things to the central office in Bismarck.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank SFN 60806 from the North Dakota Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Division at <https://dot.nd.gov/forms/sfn60806.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	YOU	Title Number and Title Issue Date	The certificate that carries the wrong reading, identified by number and by the date it was issued. Watch out: Both are printed on the certificate itself, which is going back to the department with this form anyway.
2	YOU	Corrected Odometer Reading	The reading as it should have been recorded at the time the error occurred. Watch out: Historical, not current. Your service records have to support this figure at that date, which is why the department asks for records from either side of it.
3	YOU	Vehicle Identification Number	The VIN of the vehicle whose record is being corrected. Watch out: Check it against the certificate. The department's field ordering on this form is idiosyncratic and it is easy to write the number into the wrong line.
4	YOU	The odometer reading was recorded incorrectly because	A free-text explanation - what the correct figure was, what was written instead, and how it happened. Watch out: Name the evidence you are attaching, with dates and readings. This block is what a reviewer reads first, and vague is the enemy of a corrected title.
5	YOU	Name of individual requesting the correction	Last, first, middle, with a telephone number and full mailing address. Watch out: The requester is whoever made the original error. If that was the buyer, this is the buyer's application and the buyer's notary appointment.
6	YOU	Name printed and signature	Under penalties of perjury, signed before a Notary Public or Authorized Officer. Watch out: Assemble the four other documents first - the secure disclosure where a sale was involved, the \$5.00 title fee, the original certificate and the service records - so the whole package goes in one envelope.
7	OTHER	The Acknowledgment block	State, county, sworn date, the notary's printed name, stamp, signature and commission expiration date. Watch out: The officer's, not yours. And the whole package goes to the central office address printed at the top of the form, not to a branch.

What gets this one rejected

- Sending it without the original mis-issued certificate. It is item four on the department's own list, and the correction is a replacement of that document rather than an annotation of it.
- Records from only one side of the error. The department asks for service, maintenance or repair records validating the mileage before and after the title was issued - a single recent invoice does not bracket anything.
- Skipping the secure disclosure where the mistake happened during a sale. Item two on the list requires it, completed in full with the appropriate signatures from seller and buyer, and the department issues it on request rather than publishing it.
- Sending it to a branch. This one goes to the address printed at the head of the form - the Motor Vehicle Division's central office in Bismarck.
- Signing before a notary is present. It is a sworn statement under penalties of perjury, like the department's other affidavits.

1. SFN 60806 Odometer Correction
2. SFN 18773 Reassignment/Odometer Disclosure must be submitted with the corrected odometer reading when the error occurred during an ownership change. This will require the form to be completed in full with the appropriate signatures from seller and buyer.
3. Title fee - \$5.00
4. Original title issued with incorrect mileage
5. A series of service/maintenance or repair records that validate the vehicle's mileage **BEFORE AND AFTER** the title was issued.

* At the Division's discretion, additional documentation may be requested at any time.
