

How to fill out VTR-267 — Additional Liens Statement

Records a second and third lien on a Texas title. The Form 130-U has room for one lienholder; when a vehicle carries more than one, this goes with it. It is the buyer's form, filed with their own title application - a seller meets it only when the person buying their car is financing through more than one lender.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank VTR-267 from the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles at https://www.txdmv.gov/sites/default/files/form_files/VTR-267.pdf — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	BUYER	Vehicle information	VIN, year, make, body style and model, matching the Form 130-U it travels with. Watch out: Any mismatch between this and the 130-U sends both back.
2	BUYER	Second lien	Lien date, lienholder name, certified lienholder ID number and mailing address. Watch out: The lien date is the date of the security agreement, not the date you fill this in.
3	BUYER	Third lien	The same block again, if there is a third lender. Watch out: Leave it blank if there is not. An empty block is not a defect.
4	BUYER	Sign and date	Signature, printed name and date for the applicant, and a second row if the title will carry two owners. Watch out: The printed name has to match the signature - the form asks for it in those words.

What gets this one rejected

- Filing it on its own. The form says it must be submitted with the Application for Texas Title and/or Registration (Form 130-U).
- Putting the first lien on it. The first lienholder goes on the 130-U; this form starts at the second.
- Mixing it with an electronic lien. The instruction is explicit: more than one lien cannot be recorded in combination with an electronic lien.
- Leaving the certified lienholder ID number blank when the lender has one.

This form must be submitted with the *Application for Texas Title and/or Registration* (Form 130-U) when more than one lien needs to be recorded on the Texas title.

More than one lien cannot be recorded in combination with an electronic lien. If more than one lien is recorded, a paper title will be issued to the first lienholder listed on the *Application for Texas Title and/or Registration* (Form 130-U).
