

How to fill out MV-600 — Application for Rebuilt Salvage Vehicle Decal

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Wyoming · written against MV-600 (9/22), issued under WYDOT Motor Vehicle Services under W.S. 31-2-108; the decal is issued by the department and the title is issued by the county clerk

A Wyoming salvage title comes with restricted registration, which is the state's polite way of saying the vehicle is not going back on the road on that paper. This application is how it does: the department issues a rebuilt salvage decal, the owner sticks it on the vehicle, law enforcement inspects the identification number, and the whole file then goes to the county clerk for a title and plates. Four numbered steps on one page - who you are and what the vehicle is, who rebuilt it and what was wrong with it, a sworn affidavit that no stolen parts went into it, and the Cheyenne address it gets posted to. There is no fee for the decal, which makes it the cheapest step in a very expensive process.

This sheet is not the form. Download the blank MV-600 from the Wyoming Department of Transportation, Motor Vehicle Services at <https://www.dot.state.wy.us/files/live/sites/wydot/files/shared/Motor%20Vehicle%20Services/MV-600%20REBUILT%20DECAL%20APPLICATION%209-22.pdf> — always take the current revision from the agency rather than a copy. Print this and keep it beside you while you complete theirs.

Every line, in the order you meet it

1	YOU	Get the Wyoming salvage title first	Apply at the county clerk's office for a Wyoming salvage title with restricted registration, in your own name. Watch out: The clerk's office hands you this application at the same visit. If somebody has sent you this form without a salvage title in your name, you are a step early.
2	YOU	Applicant and vehicle	Your name exactly as it appears on the salvage title, your contact details, then make, year, identification number, model, body style and the Wyoming title number. Watch out: Exactly as it appears matters here more than usual - the department is matching this application against a title record that already exists.
3	YOU	Name the rebuilder in full	The person or business that rebuilt or repaired the vehicle, with a daytime phone and a physical address. Watch out: A shop's trading name and its physical address are both wanted. A mobile number and a first name is the version that comes back.
4	YOU	Describe the damage properly	What was wrong with the vehicle before the repair, in the deep box that must be completed in order to process. Watch out: Write it as a list of what was damaged and what was replaced. Panels, structure, mechanical, airbags - the department is judging whether this is a repair or a reassembly.
5	YOU	Post it with the title copy and the photographs	A copy of the Wyoming certificate of title branded salvage and photographs of the repaired vehicle, to Motor Vehicle Services at the Cheyenne address in step four. Watch out: Take the photographs in daylight from all four corners. This is the department's only view of the vehicle and a dark phone picture of one wing does not help you.
6	YOU	Fit the decal where the form says	Driver's side door jamb on a car; on a motorcycle, the fork crown, without obscuring the identification number. Watch out: Do it as soon as the decal arrives and before you book the inspection. Clean the jamb first - a decal that lifts is a decal that gets queried at the next sale.
7	OTHER	Get the identification number certified, then go back to the clerk	Law enforcement inspects the vehicle and signs the certification that comes with the decal, and the whole file then goes to your county clerk for titling and plates. Watch out: Book the inspection where the vehicle is, not where you are. A rebuilt truck that is not road legal yet cannot lawfully drive itself to a sheriff's office.

What gets this one rejected

- Applying before the salvage title exists. The route starts at the county clerk with an application for a Wyoming salvage title in the owner's name, and the clerk's office is what hands you this form.
- Leaving the damage description thin. The form says it must be completed in order to process, and a line reading repaired front end tells the department nothing it can assess.
- Naming yourself as the rebuilder without an address. If you did the work, the block still wants a name, a physical address and a telephone number, because somebody may ring to ask about it.
- Sending it without the attachments. A copy of the Wyoming certificate of title branded salvage and photographs of the repaired vehicle travel with the application; the form says so in capitals above the affidavit.
- Fitting the decal after the inspection. The instruction is explicit that application of the decal must be completed before the Wyoming law enforcement inspection, and an officer who arrives to find no decal will not certify anything.

(Note: Vehicles that are deemed salvage from Hail or Theft are NOT required to get a Rebuilt Salvage Decal per W.S.31-2-108(c)) <i>Struck head on. Radiator support, both frame horns, hood, left fender and headlamp assembly replaced; frame pulled and measured to factory specification; no airbag deployment.</i>			
STEP #3	Apply rebuilt salvage decal to the driver's side door jamb. On a motorcycle apply decal to the fork crown in a manner that does not obscure the vehicle identification number. Application of decal must be completed before Wyoming Law Enforcement inspection.			
	APPLICANTS MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF THE WYOMING CERTIFICATE OF TITLE BRANDED "SALVAGE" AND PHOTOS OF THE REPAIRED VEHICLE WITH THIS APPLICATION.			
	AFFIDAVIT I HEREBY SWEAR OR AFFIRM that I am the owner of the vehicle described. I declare that the information contained in this application is complete and accurate and, to the best of my knowledge, no stolen parts were used during the rebuilding of this vehicle. ANY PERSON CONVICTED OF MAKING A FALSE STATEMENT ON AN APPLICATION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND IS SUBJECT TO A FINE AND IMPRISONMENT.
